### **PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY**

#### HONORS PATHWAY ONE:

Students who have completed at least 12 transfer-level college units are eligible if they have a minimum 3.0 GPA and are eligible for, or have successfully completed, ENGWR 300.

#### HONORS PATHWAY TWO:

Students who have completed less than 12 transfer-level college units are eligible if they have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA and at least one of the following:

- 1) Grade of B or better in APpreparatory Honors English.
- 2) Grade of B or better in AP or IB English.
- 3) Score of 4 or 5 on the AP English Language and Composition Exam.

## HONORS PATHWAY THREE (CHALLENGE PATHWAY):

Any student is eligible if they submit a successful Honors Program Challenge Application, demonstrating to the satisfaction of the Honors Admissions Committee their interest, motivation, preparation and potential for Honors Program study.

Students may apply for general (unrestricted) or restricted program admission (i.e. request special permission to enroll in a limited number of Honors courses) via the Challenge Pathway.

Note: Students who assess into ENGWR 480 or STAT 480 are guaranteed restricted admission to HONOR 375/ENGWR 480 or HONOR 393/STAT 480, respectively.
