How to Connect to CRC Wireless Access Point

INTRODUCTION

There are two wireless networks supported at CRC: LRCCD and guest.

Wireless Network Connections		LRCCD	Used for STUDENT and Employee Internet access
LRCCD guest	all all	guest	Used by GUESTS invited to the campus that have had guest login accounts created

While you may see more wireless networks show up in your wireless connection manager, depending on your radio antenna size and location, only the ones shown are used for CRC Internet access as described above.

Making a Wireless Connection



Select the LRCCD network.



Select connect.

STEP 3 You will be prompted to enter your LRCCD account (e.g.W1234567) and password. This is the same username and password used for: E-Services for LRCCD Students and Outlook Web Access for LRCCD Employees.

NOTE: If you receive a certificate error message: accept/continue/install would be the correct choices.

Having Problems Connecting?

STUDENTS/ FACULTY & STAFF:

- 1 On your device, make sure your WiFi is turned on.
- 2 Students & Employees: make sure you are connected to LRCCD.
- Make sure you are entering your username and 3 password correctly.

GUESTS (invited to campus that have had a guest access account provided):

- - Make sure your wireless radio is turned on.
- Make sure you are connected to the **guest** wireless 2 connection.
- Launch your Internet browser and enter the 3

- Turn your wireless connection off, and back on, 4 to reset your wireless connection, and try again.
- 5 Remove any previously remembered (choose "forget" on iPhone and Android devices) connections related to CRC networks, and try again.
- Launch your Internet browser if you haven't been 6 prompted for your username and password, this may cause the login dialog box to pop up.
- Restart your computer, and try again.
