Schedule preliminary financial aid meeting. Schedule a preliminary meeting with a financial aid representative at your current campus to discuss eligibility, potential award amounts, and other funding sources: ARC -> Dan Alexander (alexand@arc.losrios.edu); CRC -> Phuong Le (lep@crc.losrios.edu); FLC -> Irina Randak (randaki@flc.losrios.edu); or SCC -> Maritza LaVu (lavum@scc.losrios.edu).
<u>Preview course applicability with a counselor</u> . Financial aid can only be used for classes that apply toward your specific degree or certificate pathway. You are highly encouraged to meet with a counselor at your current campus to review the Florence course options and determine which classes are applicable for financial aid. You should bring the Florence 2025 Course Packet to the meeting: tinyurl.com/Flo25Courses .
<u>Declare an eligible major</u> . Only specific majors are eligible for financial aid. In consultation with a counselor, consider which major best meets your academic goals while maintaining financial aid eligibility. For example, some student may choose Transfer to 4-Yr Institution . Undecided majors are not eligible. Majors can be changed in eServices : https://ps.losrios.edu/student/signon.html .
<u>Update and/or complete your FAFSA</u> . To be considered for the California College Promise Grant (CCPG) tuition waiver and other financial aid opportunities you must complete the 2024-25 FAFSA: https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa . Be sure to add American River College (001232), College of San Mateo (001181), Santa Rosa Junior College (001287), and Diablo Valley College (001191) as potential schools.
Meet with study abroad program director Adam Windham. Once you have paid your \$450 deposit, you will be scheduled a meeting time with study abroad program director Adam Windham. At that meeting, he will review your application materials and verify your eligibility for the program.
Meet with campus financial aid representative. After being accepted into the program, schedule a second meeting with your financial aid representative: ARC -> Dan Alexander (alexand@arc.losrios.edu); CRC -> Phuong Le (lep@crc.losrios.edu); FLC -> Irina Randak (randaki@flc.losrios.edu); or SCC -> Maritza LaVu (lavum@scc.losrios.edu). The financial aid process can take several weeks so plan ahead!
 Financial aid representatives will help you: Review your financial aid options Read and sign any required American Institute for Foreign Study (AIFS) paperwork Complete and submit requisite Study Abroad Consortium Request forms for classes you take through College of San Mateo, Santa Rosa Junior College, or Diablo Valley College. Review your eServices status and determine next steps
Monitor your financial aid status in eServices. Visit: https://ps.losrios.edu/student/signon.html often. Select Message Center, Tasks, and Financial Aid tiles for current information and missing documentation.
<u>Apply for Scholarships</u> . All scholarships have different processes and deadlines. Don't wait until the last minute!

<u>Apply for Federal Direct Loans</u> : A direct loan is money you borrow from the federal government that you have to pay back with interest. <u>bit.ly/3REKjhn</u>
Apply for Private Loans: If you are not eligible to receive direct loans, you may opt for a private loan. A private loan is money you borrow from a private lender that you have to pay back with interest. bit.ly/3Dw3qnC

You are responsible for all AIFS program fees if your preference is not activated. Refund preferences include having refunds kept in your BankMobile account, sent to an existing bank account, or mailed as a physical check. If you request check, verify that your correct mailing address is on file in eServices: ps.losrios.edu/student/signon.html.
